THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND

RE: PETITION TO ALTER PORTIONS OF MEADOW ROAD AND
OLD NATIONAL PIKE

RECITALS

The Frederick County Division of Public Works filed a petition to alter portions of Meadow Road and Old National Pike, pursuant to the Annotated Code of Maryland, Local Government Article, §12-512.

The petition proposed altering an approximately 0.10-mile-long portion of Meadow Road and altering an approximately 0.22-mile-long portion of Old National Pike by the creation of an on ramp from Meadow Road onto I-70 westbound, an off ramp from I-70 eastbound onto Old National Pike near its intersection with Meadow Road, adjustments to Old National Pike and Meadow Road to accommodate the ramps, reconfiguration of the intersections of MD 144 and Old National Pike and Meadow Road and Old National Pike to install traffic signals, and the elimination of a “free right” lane from the westbound I-70 exit to westbound MD 144.

The petition also requested that the modified areas of Meadow Road and Old National Pike be declared surplus, to enable the transfer of those roads segments to the State Highway Administration.

The Division of Public Works recommended approval of the petition.

The County Council held a public hearing on September 22, 2020 consider the petition, during which hearing members of the public and representatives of the Division of Public Works and the State Highway Administration were provided the opportunity to comment.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND,

1. That the Petition to Alter Portions of Meadow Road and Old National Pike as shown on Exhibit A is approved.
2. That the County Council finds the altered areas of Meadow Road and Old National Pike currently maintained by the County to be "surplus" for the purpose of transferring those roadways to the State of Maryland,


AND, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the County Executive is hereby authorized to transfer the rights-of-way of the altered portions of Meadow Road and Old National Pike, as shown on Exhibit A, to the State of Maryland.




