

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND

RESOLUTION NO. 21-37

RE: SUMMER 2021 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS – CASE WS-21-24

Applicant: Hooper Family, LLC

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan (“W/S Plan”) after a duly advertised public hearing.

Case WS-21-24 proposes the reclassification of a 0.74-acre parcel of land on Tax Map 57, Parcel 21, which is located on the East Side of Yellow Springs Road at Old West Seventh Street, from S-5 to S-4. The property is designated R-3 Residential, and is currently zoned Agricultural/ Rural.

The S-4 classification is assigned to properties designated residential, commercial, or industrial, or in general, a category other than Agricultural or Rural or Natural Resource on the County Comprehensive Plan, and where improvements to, or construction of, publicly-owned community sewerage or water systems are planned within the 4-6 year time period.

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed Water and Sewer Plan amendments on December 7, 2021, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND that the following W/S Plan amendment requested in Case WS 21-24 is necessary and hereby approved: reclassification of a 0.74-acre parcel of land on Tax Map 57, Parcel 21, which is located on the East Side of Yellow Springs Road at Old West Seventh Street, from S-5 to S-4.

There undersigned hereby certifies that the amendment described in this Resolution was approved and adopted (by a vote of 6-0-1) on the December 7, 2021.
