Update from City of Frederick

David Edmondson with the City of Frederick updated the committee on what the city is planning for bike lanes and trails. The committee asked several questions and commented on protected bike lanes and trail projects. Lib and Shayne asked if we could do a joint meeting every year with the City BPAC. After discussion the committee decided that the March meeting would be a good time to meet.

Staff Updates

Joe Kelley reported that after two years working with the state on the Fred. & Penn. Trail the state has now decided to Rail Bank the corridor in order to protect the Right of Way. The rail banking will take from 1 year to 18 months to implement. Joe also reported that the county will be seeking grants to study bikeway selection for the section of New Design Road from Crestwood Blvd to the City of Frederick and to design and construct protected bike lanes on NDR from English Muffin Way to Crestwood Blvd.

Vladimir Tolskiy asked if the plastic poles really help make protected bike lanes safer.
