

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND**

**RESOLUTION NO. 22-15**

**RE: FALL 2021 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS – CASE WS-21-37**

Applicant: Division of Planning and Permitting and the Frederick County Health Department

**RECITALS**

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan (“W/S Plan”) after a duly advertised public hearing.

Case WS-21-37 proposes the reclassification of a 0.96-acre parcel of land located on 7821 and 7825 Rocky Springs Road, Frederick Maryland, 21702, from S-5 to S-4. The property is designated Low Density Residential, and is currently zoned R-1 Residential.

The S-4 classification is assigned to properties designated residential, commercial, or industrial, or in general, a category other than Agricultural or Rural or Natural Resource on the County Comprehensive Plan, and where improvements to, or construction of, publicly-owned community sewerage or water systems are planned within the 4-6 year time period. This sewer reclassification will reflect the location of new sewer infrastructure to the subject property, and will provide the future ability for the property owner to obtain public sewer service.


The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed W/S Plan amendment on May 31, 2022, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.




