RECITALS

Whereas, Resolution 12-09, passed by the Board of County Commissioners on the 12th day of July, 2012, required that any member of a board, commission, or committee subject to appointment by the Board of County Commissioners must be a bona fide resident of and a registered voter in Frederick County; and

Whereas, the passage of Resolution 12-09 was an Executive Function of the County Government carried out by the Board of County Commissioners, which under the current Charter form of government would be a County Executive function; and


Whereas the County Executive and County Council are in agreement with the need to remove the requirements of Resolution 12-09 from county boards, commissions, and committees.




