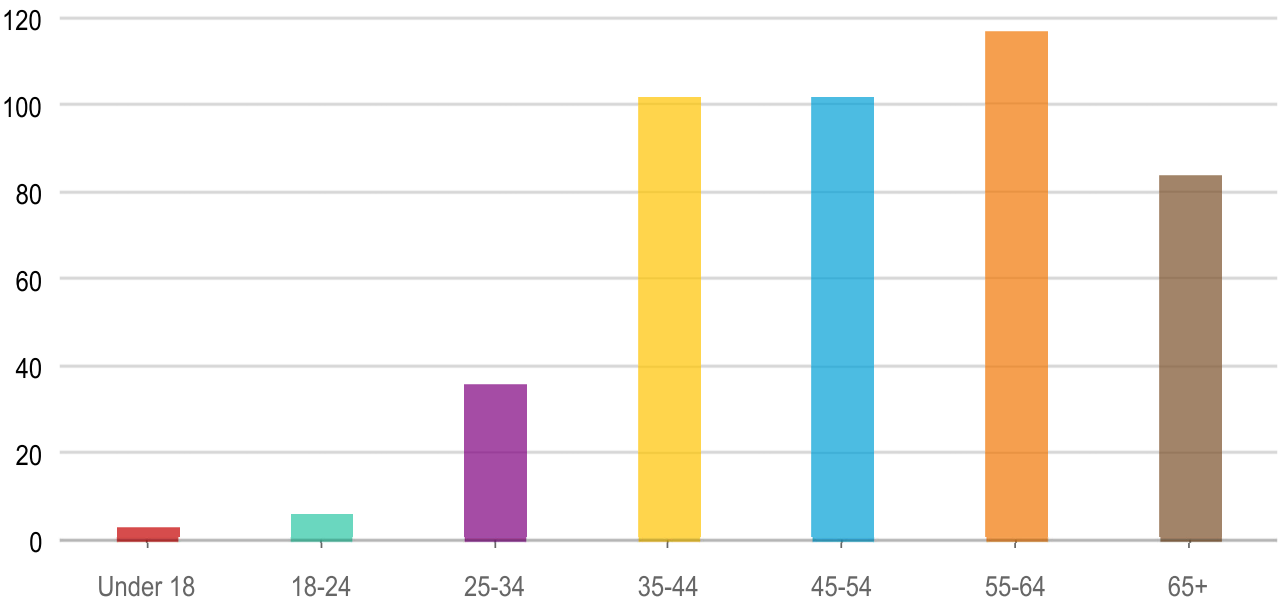

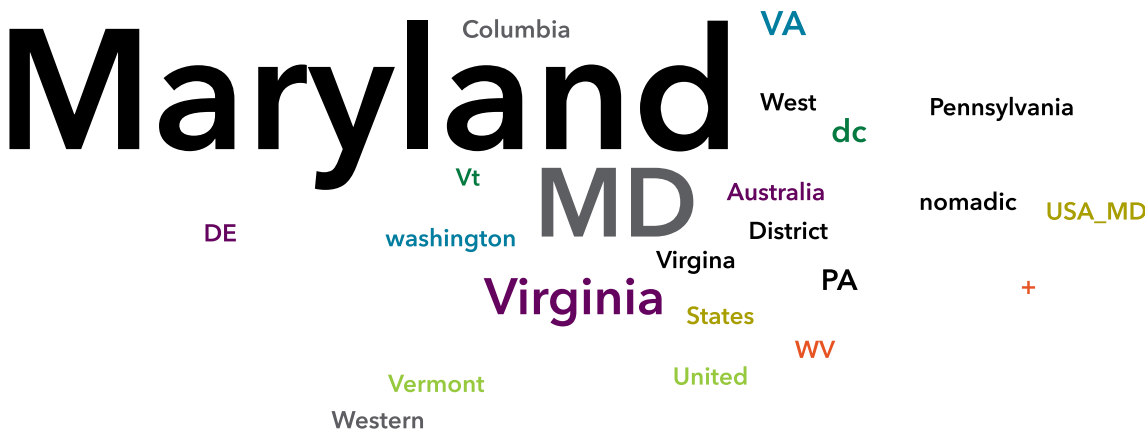
What is your age range? *

What State do you live in? *



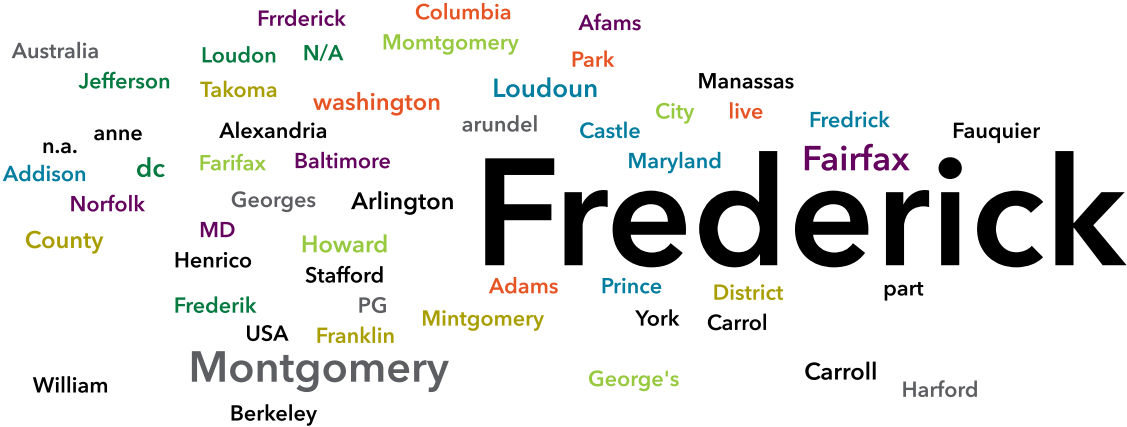

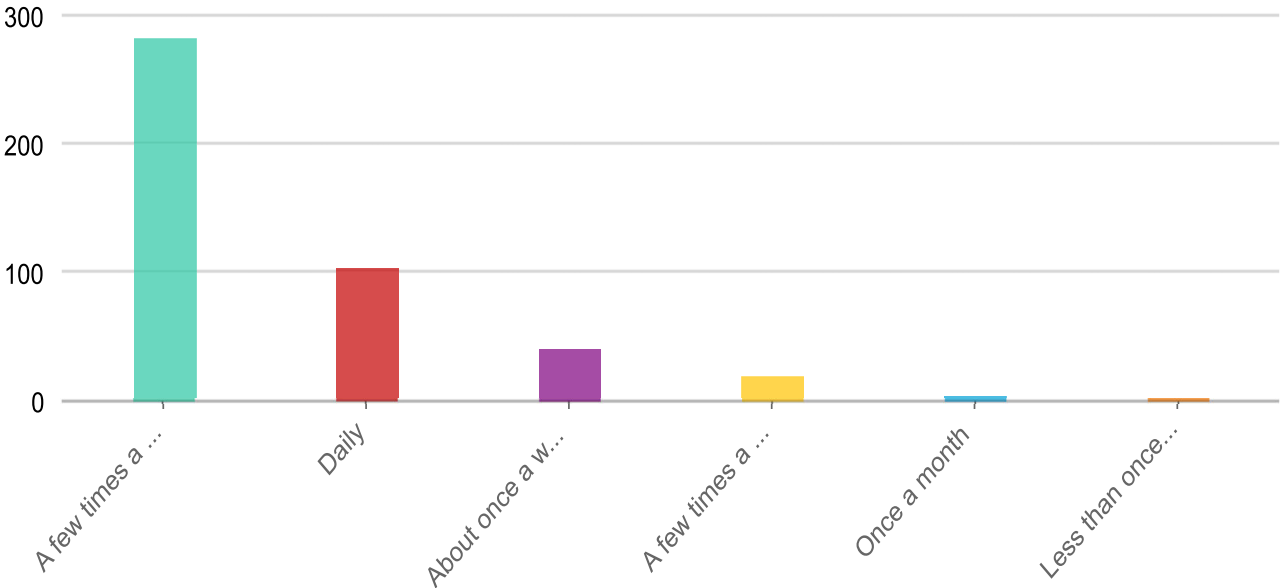

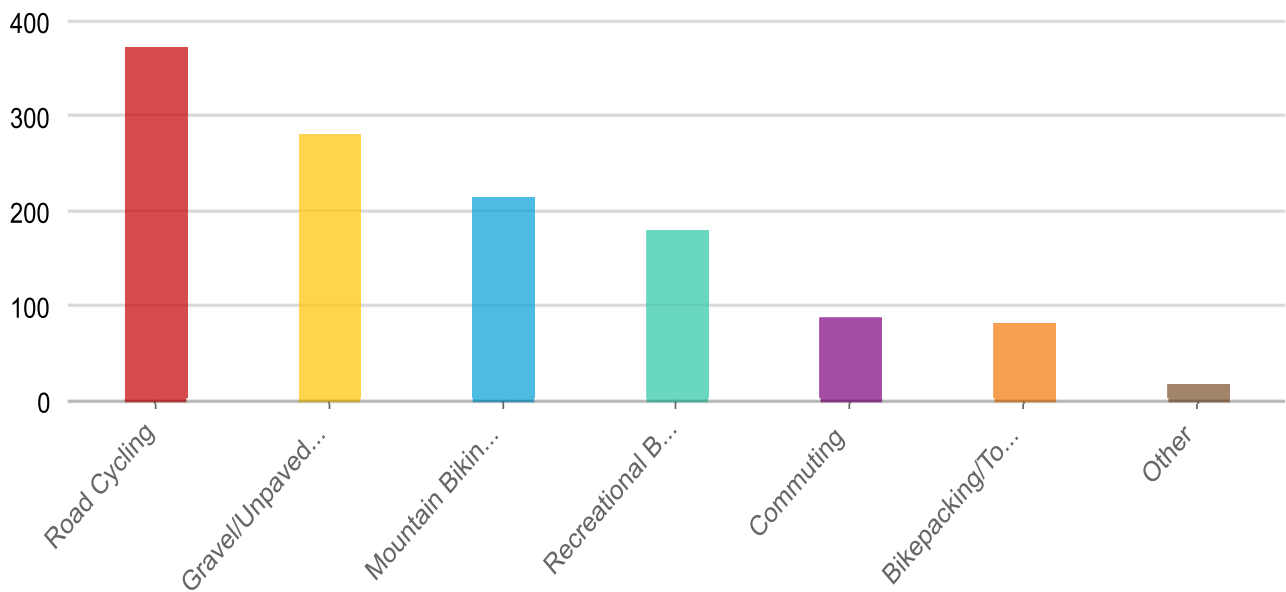
How often do you cycle a month? *

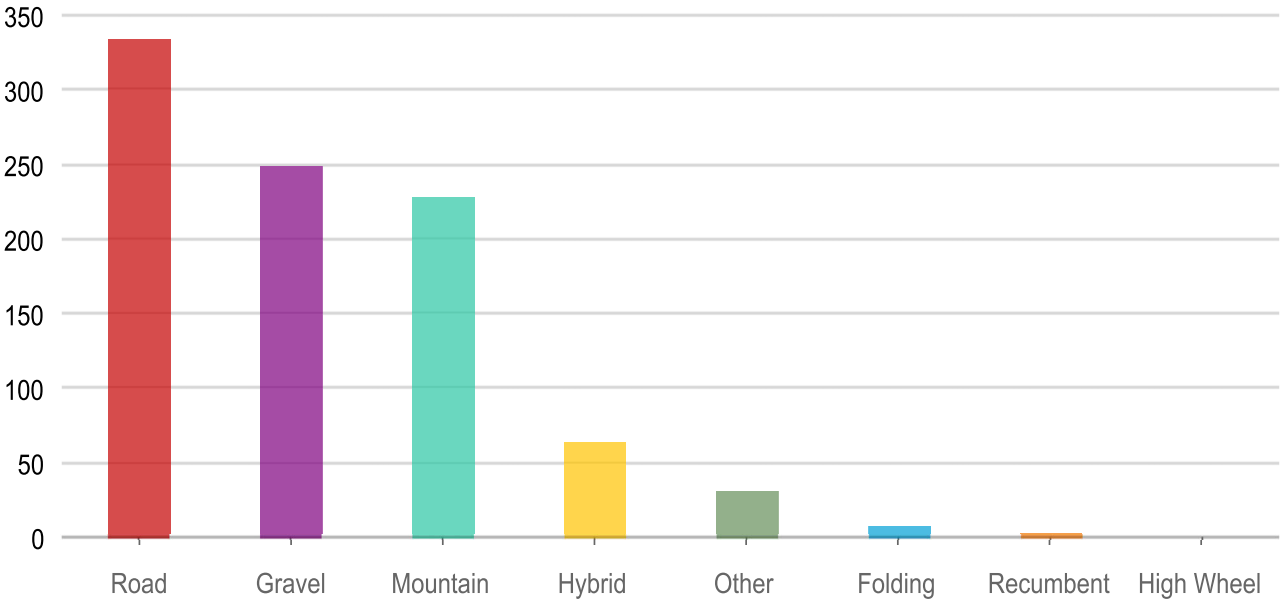
What type of cycling do you do? (Select all that apply) *

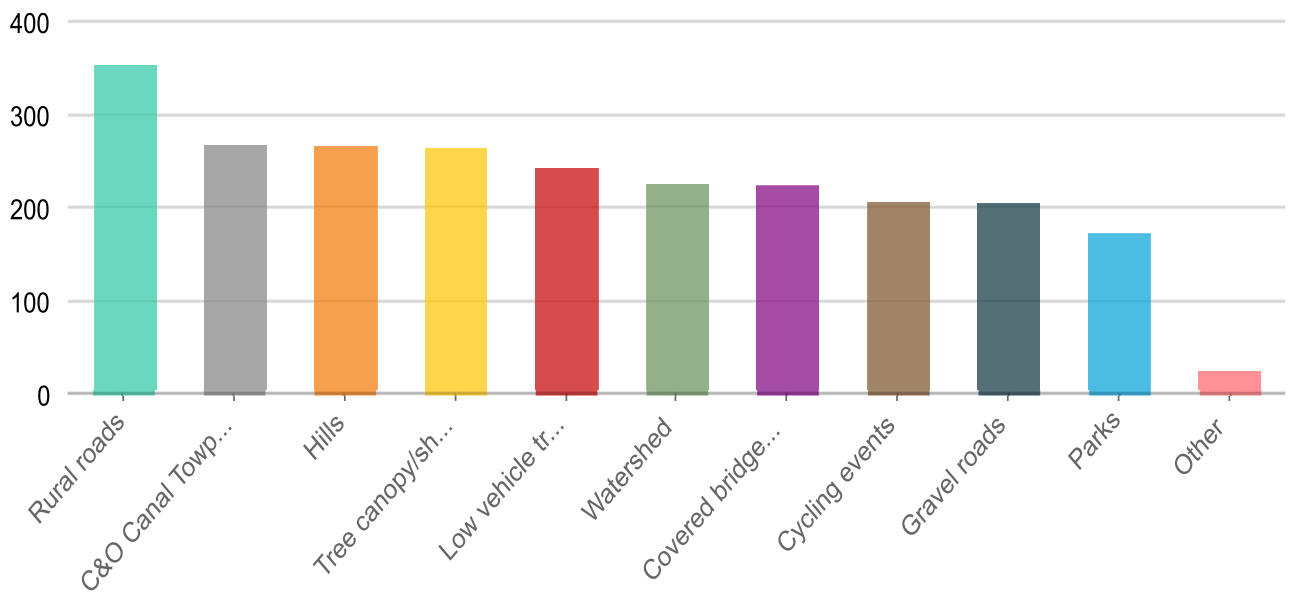

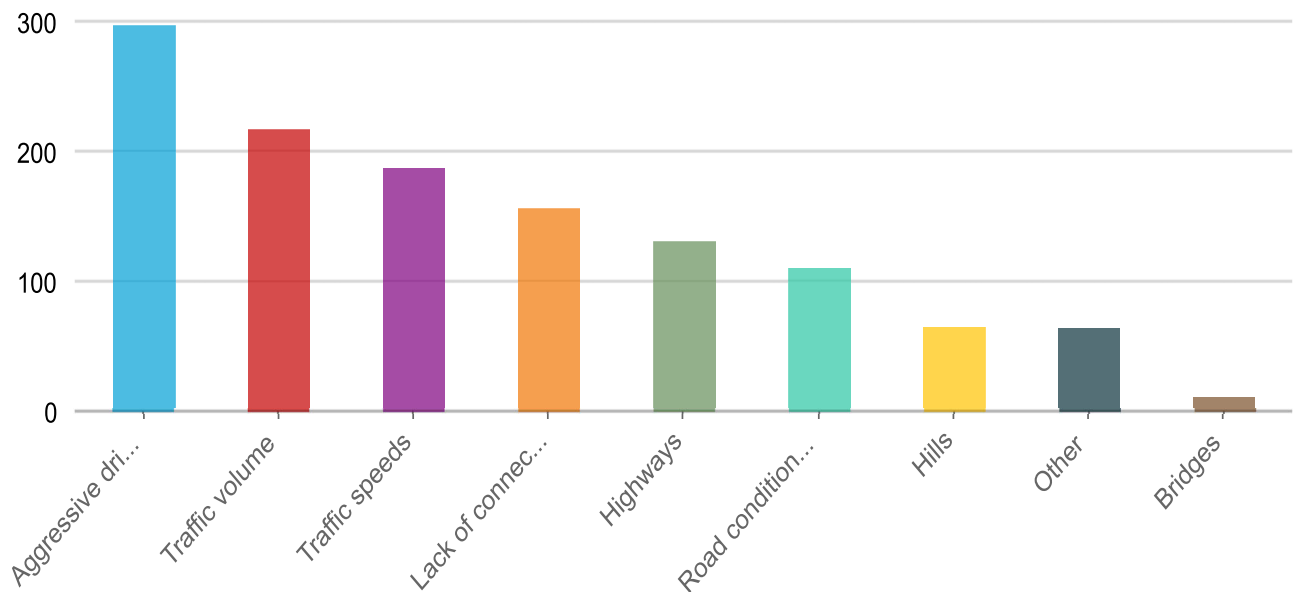

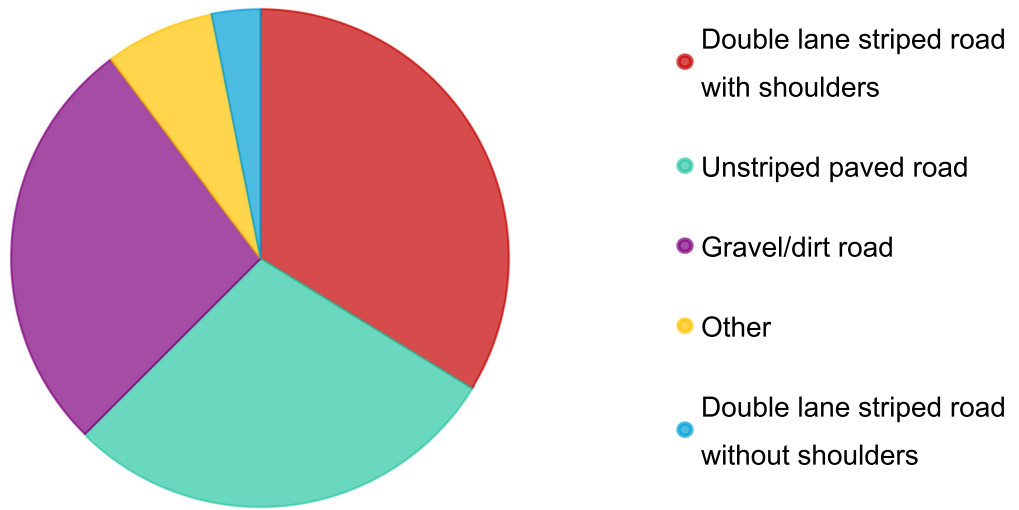
What makes cycling in Frederick County challenging? (Select all that apply) *

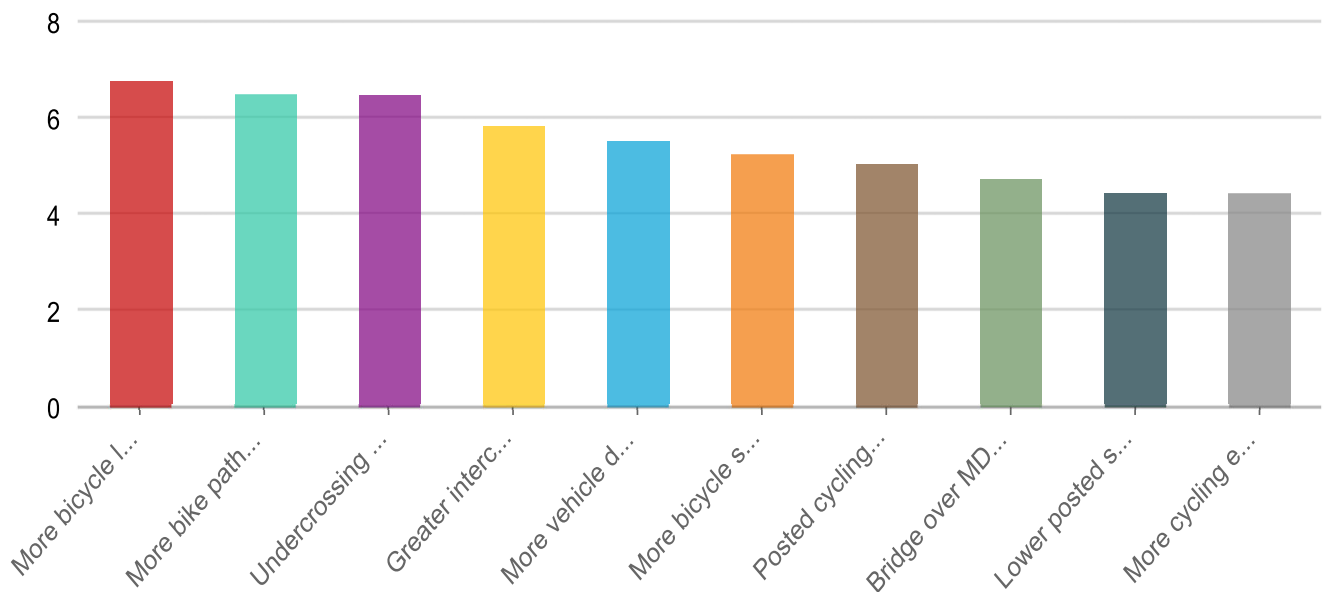
What is your ideal road for cycling? *

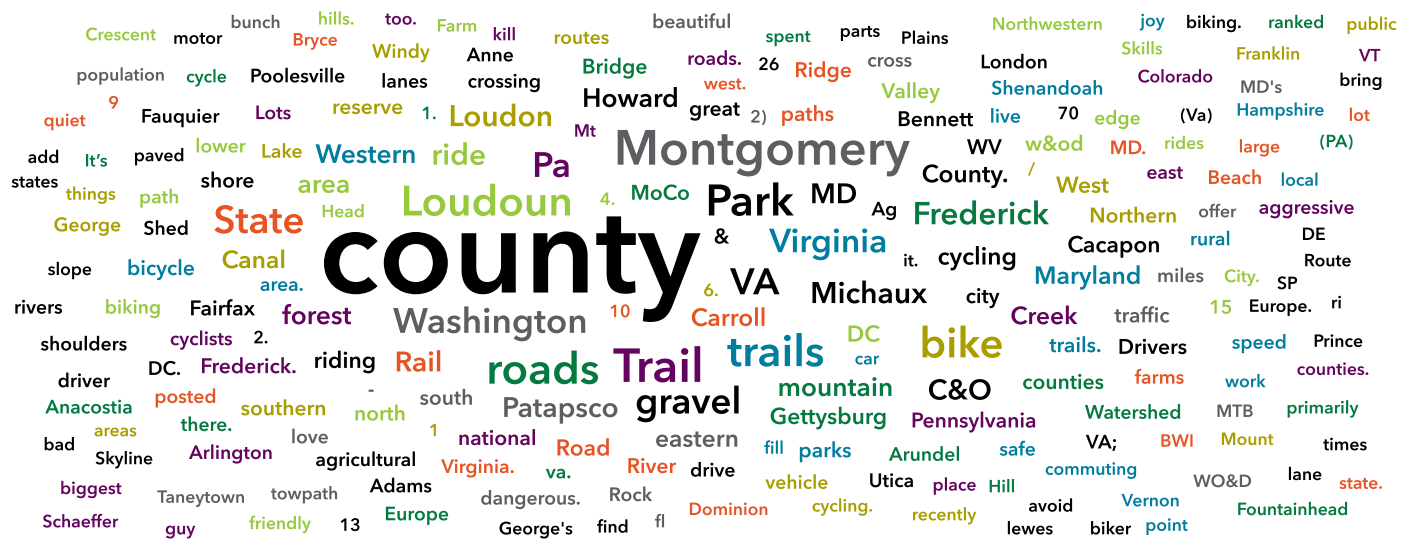

I live in Carroll now, I actually find the drivers LESS aggressive here and in Howard county than I do in Frederick. It's the lack of bike lanes, shoulders and by far the worst issue, aggressive drivers which has me avoiding Frederick County these days. I typically cycle between 3000-6000 miles per year.	1
I like to ride in Rock Creek Park in DC. They have blocked off the roads there, so it is a beautiful space for riding and running all the time. Safe from drivers...dogs on long leashes or not at all are the only real worry there. I ride in Frederick 3-6 times a month. Spend most of it in the Shed or along Gambrill heading up to Catocin Mtn. There are two things that would make Frederick County amazing for riding. 1) a bridge or tunnel to cross 15 at a point north near Thurmont/Cat. Hollow Road (too bad we cannot use the hiking bridge; there are more cyclists than hikers) and a little further south near Utica Park or Devil Bliss Bridge Rd. And 2) an ongoing program to strictly enforce speed limits and foster safe driving where cyclists frequent. Excessive speed recently killed a person on their bike on 15, where there is no alternative to cross except where drivers cross, and the drivers go 70 mph where it is posted as 55 mph.
