MINUTES

The Adult Public Guardianship Review Board met at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, March 3, 2025, virtually.

Open Session:

- I. The Board reviewed the Minutes from the meeting held on December 9, 2024. Sandi Wastler moved to approve the Minutes and Tressa Bell seconded the Motion.
- II. The Board discussed the following:
