Requesting a special exception to establish a Non-Governmental Utility (Substation) per Sections 1-19-3.210, 1-19-5.310, and 1-19-8.339 of the Frederick County Zoning Ordinance, located on the west side of Bartholows Road at its intersections with Cowman's Manor Drive and West Oak Dr. (Tax Map 89, Parcel 166, and Tax Map 89, Parcel 21 and Block 150) Zoned Agricultural

The hearing will begin at 7:00 P.M. with continuation of Presentations by the Applicant.
