

FREDERICK COUNTY BOARD OF APPEALS MEETING MINUTES FOR

Cases

B-13-08 William J. Beam as represented by Barry J.C. Kissin

An application was filed claiming an Appeal of Administrative Error in the zoning Administrator's application of Section 1-19-8.700, Temporary Outdoor Activities for a property located at the corner of Ballenger Creek Pike and East Basford Rd (2650 Ballenger Creek Pike, Tax Map 103, Parcel 153, Tract 2) – Zoned Agricultural.

Mr. Terry read the staff report. Mr. Smith read the agencies comments. The board members noted their observations during their scheduled site visit on Wednesday, June 21, 2013.

On a motion from Mr. Bowersox seconded by Mr. Capoccia, the Board unanimously granted the appeal as the proposed future activity planned based on testimony during the hearing is not a Temporary Outdoor Activity as defined in Section 1-19-8.700. (Yea 5-0)
