RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL
OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND

RE: FALL 2014 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland has the authority to approve or deny amendments to its county water and sewerage plan after a duly advertised public hearing.

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed changes to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan on April 21, 2015, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND that the County Council hereby finds the amendments requested in Case # WS-14-26, Case #WS-14-27, and Case #WS-14-28 are necessary and are hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the County Council hereby finds that the request in Case #WS-14-25 to reclassify 31.4 acres to W-4, S-4 is necessary and is hereby approved; however, the request in Case #WS-14-25 to place a sewage pump station symbol on the Sewer Map is denied, due to the submission of insufficiently detailed information for determining the proper size and location of the pump station; and

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on April 21, 2015.
