RE: FALL 2016 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS - CASE #WS-16-15

Applicant: Division of Permitting & Planning/Urbana Elementary School

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing. Case #WS-16-15 proposes reclassification of 19.8 acres (Tax Map 96, Parcel 71) located in Frederick County from W-5/Dev. to W-3/Dev.

The property is located along the south side of Urbana Pike (MD 355) in Urbana, is designated Institutional on the County Comprehensive Plan, zoned R-1 Residential, and is within the Urbana Community Growth Area. The Urbana Elementary School is located on the site and is currently served by a private well.

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed changes on June 6, 2017, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND that the W/S Plan amendment requested in Case #WS-16-15 is necessary and is hereby approved.
