RE: SPRING 2017 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS - CASE #WS-17-03  
Applicant: County Division of Planning and Permitting

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing.

Case #WS-17-03 proposes the reclassification of 0.31 acres (Tax Map 84, part of Parcel 203) located in Frederick County on the south side of Jefferson Pike, west of Horine Road from No Planned Service to W-3/Dev. due to well contamination.

The property is designated Agricultural/Rural on the County Comprehensive Plan, located within the Jefferson Community Growth Area, and zoned Agricultural.

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed change on September 5, 2017, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND that the W/S Plan amendment requested in Case #WS-17-03 is necessary and the change to W-3/Dev. of 0.31 acres surrounding the dwelling on the parcel is hereby approved by a vote of 7-0.
