Applicant: Division of Planning and Permitting/Storm Property

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing.

Case #WS-17-09 proposes the reclassification of 0.75 acres (Tax Map 79, Parcel 70) located on the north side off Old National Pike, 580 feet west of Mussetter Road from W-5/Dev. W-3/Dev.

The property is designated Low Density Residential within the Linganore Community Growth Area and zoned Residential (R-1).

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed changes on December 19, 2017, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND that the W/S Plan amendment requested in Case #WS-17-09 is necessary and is hereby approved.
