RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing.

Case #WS-17-11 proposes the reclassification of Lot 1 (Tax Map 58, Parcel 302) located on the south side of MD 194, Woodsboro Pike, within the Town of Walkersville, from No Planned Service (NPS) to W-3/Dev., S-5/Dev.

The property is designated Agriculture in the Town of Walkersville Comprehensive Plan and zoned Agriculture (Town of Walkersville).

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed changes on June 19, 2018, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.






