RESOLUTION NO. 19-27

RE: SUMMER 2019 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS - CASE WS-19-06

Applicant: Town of Walkersville (Escobar Property)

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing.

Case WS-19-06 proposes the reclassification of a 0.48-acre parcel of land on Tax Map 850, Parcel 769, which is located on the southeast side of Biggs Ford Road in the Town of Walkersville, from S-5/Dev. to S-3. The property is designated Low Density Residential on the Town Comprehensive Plan, and zoned R-1 (Town zoning).

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed W/S Plan amendments on November 19, 2019, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND that the W/S Plan amendments requested in Case WS-19-06 are necessary and hereby approved.
