 - i. The mission of Heartly House is to end domestic violence, sexual assault, human trafficking, and child abuse, and to provide victims with safety, shelter, and supportive services.
 - ii. They have recently added human trafficking to their mission statement as this is a core focus of the services that Heartly House provides
 - **b.** Heartly House is a trauma-informed agency. The hotline is 24 hours per day.
 - **c.** Heartly House recently opened The Cottage that allows for space for trainings; there will be a public opening in April. The address is: 324 West Patrick Street. There is also a legal office at 326 West Patrick Street.
 - **d.** They also discussed the Sexual Assault Task Force. It is still in the beginning stages of collecting information.
