

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND

RESOLUTION NO. 21-07

RE: DESIGNATION TO THE FREDERICK COUNTY HISTORIC REGISTER

Subject Property: Prosperity Farm (CR 16-02)

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §8-105 of the Land Use Article of the Maryland Code, a local jurisdiction may designate boundaries for sites, structures, and districts that are considered to be of historic, archaeological, or architectural significance, by following the procedures of the local jurisdiction.

In accordance with §1-23-6 of the Frederick County Code, landmarks, sites, structures, or districts of historic, archeological, or architectural significance may be proposed for designation to the Frederick County Register of Historic Places. The Frederick County Historic Preservation Commission must first hold a public meeting to determine if the landmark, site, structure or district identified in the petition meets the requirements for historic designation as set forth in §1-23-6(B).

If these requirements are met, the Historic Preservation Commission will forward the proposed petition for designation to the County Council, and the County Council will hold a public hearing and vote whether or not to recommend designation to the Frederick County Register of Historic Places.

The Historic Preservation Commission has recommended the above-referenced Subject Property for designation to the Frederick County Register of Historic Places. On March 2, 2021, the Frederick County Council held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed designation, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Subject Property is hereby approved for designation to the Frederick County Register of Historic Places.
