SHA Update

Christopher Ranken and Elizabeth Harris updated the committee on the pedestrian and bicycle access at the new I270 and MD 85 partial diverging diamond intersection. Shayne talked about the connection to Crestwood Blvd and wants the county to look at Bikeway improvements along Crestwood Blvd. Christopher and Elizabeth also talked about that SHA would soon start looking at design for additional J turns on US 15 and that bicycle access will be included.

Staff Updates

Joe Kelley updated the committee on Vision Zero policy and the Complete and Green Street Manual that the Division of Planning and Permitting is working on. Staff will be applying for TAP and Bikeways funding in the next round of grant applications for the F & P Trail and New Design Road.
