**MINUTES**

The Adult Public Guardianship Review Board met at 1:00 p.m. on Monday, June 6, 2022, via WebEx.

Those in attendance were: **Scott Birdsall, Michael Nehring, Sandy Wastler, Carolyn True, Jodi Martin, Sarah Hooper, and Cristine Evans LoVetro (Chairperson).**

**Open Session:** Cristine Evans LoVetro called the virtual meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

- I. The Board reviewed and approved Minutes from meeting held on March 14, 2022.
- II. The Board voted to continue to meet virtually through WEBEX. It was unanimously agreed that virtual meetings increase ease of participation.

- III. The Board discussed recruitment of Board Members for the following positions:

  6. One professional in the field of disabilities; and
  7. One person with a physical disability.
- IV. The Frederick County Attorney, Tom Sinton, has reviewed the draft of the By-Laws and responded with comments. Cristine LoVetro has forwarded the draft to Board members who have been involved with the Committee making revisions to the By-Laws. A meeting will be scheduled to review the revisions.
