RESOLUTION NO. 16-14

RE: DESIGNATION OF THE COUNTY ATTORNEY AS THE RESIDENT
AGENT FOR FREDERICK COUNTY

The Annotated Code of Maryland, Local Government Article, §1-1301 requires that all governmental entities designate a resident agent. A resident agent is designated by corporations and other entities for the purpose of accepting, on behalf of the entity, service of process related to legal proceedings.

The County Executive and the County Council have agreed that the County Attorney, who is designated in the Charter as the chief legal officer of the County, is the appropriate official to be designated as resident agent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the County Attorney, the chief legal officer of Frederick County, is hereby designated as the resident agent for Frederick County.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that at the time an individual is appointed and confirmed as County Attorney, that individual is authorized and directed to prepare and file with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation the appropriate documentation to register as the resident agent for Frederick County, Maryland.
