RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing. Case #WS-16-14 proposes reclassification of 12.5 acres (Tax Map 40, Parcels 375 and 574) located in Frederick County from S-5/Dev. to S-4/Dev.


The properties are located along the south side of Fish Hatchery Road in Lewistown, designated General Commercial on the County Comprehensive Plan, and zoned General Commercial.

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed changes on June 6, 2017, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.
