RESOLUTION NO. 17-34

RE: SUMMER 2017 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS - CASE #WS-17-10

Applicant: Frederick County Health Department

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing.

Case #WS-17-10 proposes to amend Chapter 4, Sewerage Systems, of the Water and Sewerage Plan. The Health Department conducted a sanitary survey of the Town of Burkittsville in 2016 that identified issues with some private wells and individual on-site sewage disposal systems (septic systems). In order to be eligible for future State funding or grants to address these public health concerns, the State of Maryland requires a listing of known problem areas to be in the County Water and Sewerage Plan. Table 4.09 (Septic Problem Areas) was updated with information on Burkittsville, plus added dwelling unit and population data for other communities and subdivisions where there was no data.

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed changes on December 19, 2017, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF FREDERICK COUNTY, MARYLAND that the W/S Plan amendment requested in Case #WS-17-10 is necessary and is hereby approved.
