The Frederick County Social Services Board (“Board”) is seeking members for the upcoming year July 2022 - June 2023.

The Board serves the residents of Frederick County by providing comprehensive information regarding local social services and public administration. It also advises the agency director on local and state policies and procedures, as well serves as a designee of the County Executive for all personnel processes related to the office of Director for the Frederick County Social Services Department. This Board helps to actively support citizens who need support in our community. It also advocates for the agency with the community and elected officials.

The Board meets monthly on the fourth Wednesday of the month at 5:00 p.m., at 1888 N. Market Street, Frederick, MD 21701. The Board has been meeting virtually through the pandemic, but resumed in-person meetings in April 2022, and will continue in-person meetings if the pandemic conditions continue to allow. The Board is appointed by the County Executive with the County Council's consent to 3-year terms.
