SERVICES & ELIGIBILITY

RENTAL ASSISTANCE

Provided to clients who need a security deposit and are moving out of homelessness or having an eviction notice to prevent homelessness.

Once per 18 months. Clients must be able to pay the next months rent.



MOTEL PLACEMENT

Provided for clients who are homeless and have children or are single and have a medical condition where a physician is requesting motel placement.

Provided once per year-3 night maximum. Must have future housing plans and have applied for all available shelter.



ENERGY ASSISTANCE

Provided to clients who are low income and have a cut off notice for electric, gas, or propane

Once per 18 months. Clients must pay a portion of their bill .



GASOLINE VOUCHERS/BUS PASSES

Provided for clients who are low income and need transportation to go to work or to a medical appointment.

Once per year. Verification of medical appointment or work is required.

PRESCRIPTION ASSISTANCE

Provided to clients without health insurance, who are low income.

Provided on an emergency basis. Prescription signed by a doctor. Clients have to apply at the Med Bank for chronic conditions.



DENTAL ASSISTANCE

Provided to clients without health insurance, who are low income and in pain.

Limited funding. Provided for those in pain; on a first-come-first serve basis.



EYEGASSES ASSISTANCE

Provided to clients without health insurance, who are low income.

Provided once per year. Only for work or school. Limited to 1 per family. Funding based on local Lion's Club's



CLOTHING/FURNITURE VOUCHERS

Provided for clients who are unemployed, on a fixed income or in emergency situations.

Once per 60 days for emergency situations only. Only two times a year.

HYGIENE/HOUSEHOLD SUPPLIES

Provided for clients who are low income.

Twice per year; at least 60 days in between visits.

Primary Medical Care is provided by appointment only through the Mission of Mercy sites in Frederick, Thurmont, Mt. Airy and Brunswick.
