Community Action Agency	301-600-1506	Provides programs and services that assist mentally ill, disabled, homeless, and low-income residents. Services include, soup kitchen serving evening meals, a food pantry, and housing services.
Family Partnership	301-600-2206	Provides parents and their children nurturing support and assistance, and offers educational and career development opportunities and related services.
Families Plus	301-694-9002	Provides workshops for parents & children. Workshops include but not limited to Students Study Skills, Managing the Teen Years and Organization Skills

• Judy Center	240-236-8772	Provides comprehensive services to families with a child(ren) between the ages of birth – K. Includes parent education, family mentoring, counseling and literacy training, health education and services.
Frederick County YMCA Head Start	301-378-9140	Provides low-income families with children 3-5 yrs. A comprehensive preschool program
Heartly House	301-662-8800	Serves residents who have been impacted by domestic violence sexual assault, & child abuse.
LOCATE Child Care	877-261-0060	Individual phone counseling helps parents learn about various types of childcare programs and provides guidelines for selecting high-quality care.
