The Frederick County Board of Elections, sitting as the Board of Canvassers for said County, will begin the process of opening, reviewing, and/or counting absentee ballots cast in the November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election at 10 a.m. on Thursday, November 10.

This process will take place in the Training Room of the Board of Elections, 355 Montevue Lane, Suite 101, Frederick, MD 21702.

It is anticipated that the processing and counting of these absentee ballots may not be completed on this date. If continuation of the process is necessary, the Board of Canvassers will announce its schedule at the end of the day, and, if necessary, at the end of each subsequent day. This may mean the process would proceed on Veteran's Day, November 11.

A canvass of provisional ballots will begin at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, November 16. This process will take place in the Training Room of the Board of Elections, 355 Montevue Lane, Suite 101, Frederick, MD 21702. It is anticipated that the processing and counting of these ballots will be completed on this date. If continuation of the process is necessary, the Board of Canvassers will announce its schedule at the end of the day, and, if necessary, at the end of each subsequent day.

The second canvass of timely absentee ballots will begin at 10 a.m. on Friday, November 18. This process will take place in the Training Room of the Board of Elections, 355 Montevue Lane, Suite 101, Frederick, MD 21702. It is anticipated that the processing and counting of these ballots will be completed on this date.
