### National Air & Space Museum Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center

The Udvar-Hazy Center (Chantilly, VA) displays thousands of aviation and space artifacts, including a Lockheed SR-71 Blackbird, a Concorde, and the space shuttle *Discovery*. The Center also offers the Airbus IMAX® Theater and the Donald D. Engen Observation Tower. Visit the Mary Baker Engen Restoration Hangar where preservation of the National Air and Space Museum's collections takes place. A mezzanine provides a view of restoration projects. Lunch at the museum's McDonald's.
