Part of your application process for employment will be a Candidate Physical Ability Test ("CPAT") and preparation for this test. Below is a list of all eight parts, not necessarily in order, and attached is a more detailed description of CPAT. **This is a Pass/Fail test.** You should wear rubber-soled shoes and clothing suitable for all the activities associated with the CPAT.

This Form must be signed before you will be permitted to participate in the CPAT Fitness Mentoring Program and Test, and you must also have your physician complete the enclosed certification.

The purpose of the CPAT Fitness Mentoring Program is to prepare prospective applicants to take the CPAT, which is part of the employment application process of the Frederick County Fire Emergency Department.
