FREDERICK, MD – Frederick County Executive Jan Gardner will hold a Town Hall to receive citizen feedback on the draft [Livable Frederick Master Plan](#) at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, March 14, at Winchester Hall, 12 E. Church Street. Citizens who cannot attend in person are invited to participate through Facebook Live during the session.

“This is a great opportunity to help shape the future of our community,” said Executive Gardner. “Come out in person or online to contribute toward our vision for Frederick County.”
