### **Replacement of Hessong Bridge Road Bridge (Structure No. 15-01)**

Thank you for taking the time to attend the Replacement of Hessong Bridge Road Bridge over Little Hunting Creek Public Meeting. Please be sure to **sign-in**.

#### **Project Overview**

This Capital Improvement Program project for Hessong Bridge Road Bridge over Little Hunting Creek is to be replaced. The project will replace the existing one lane Acrow panel bridge with a two lane structure and improve the roadway approaches to meet collector standards. The new bridge/structure would also meet current design criteria (two 11 foot lanes with 5 foot shoulders).

The project will utilize a detour route from Hessong Bridge Road to Fish Hatchery Road to U.S. 15 (Catocin Mountain Highway) to MD 77/MD 550 (Main Street) to MD 550 (Jimtown Road) to Hessong Bridge Road.

#### **Current Project Schedule**

Design funding for the project is scheduled for July 1, 2018.

Construction funding for the project is proposed for July 1, 2020.
