Dill's Tavern: Tour & Lunch

The story of the Tavern (Dillsburg, PA) began in 1742 when the Dill family of Monaghan County, Ireland, received a land grant of 504 acres and set about establishing a wilderness settlement. In 1794 the stone structure that stands today as the core of Dill's Tavern and Plantation was built. In 1800 Leonard Eichelberger bought the property and doubled the size of the structure. After our tour of the tavern, we will enjoy a hardy lunch featuring "period food". Contemporary Art Museum

When you visit Glenstone (Potomac, MD), you are invited to engage directly with the art, architecture, and landscape. Glenstone assembles post-World War II artworks of the highest quality. These works are presented in a series of refined indoor and outdoor spaces. Glenstone Museum encompasses two buildings, several outdoor sculptures and more than 230 acres of landscape. **Be prepared to spend considerable time on foot; comfortable walking shoes are recommended. The first of the Museum buildings is a seven-minute walk from the Arrival Hall.**

Lunch will be at The Café which seasonal fare made fresh daily from locally sourced, sensibly raised provisions. **All transactions at Glenstone are cashless with debit and credit cards as the accepted forms of payment.**
