Kenilworth Park & Aquatic Gardens

This natural area of Anacostia Park (DC) has origins in a 1926 act of Congress to preserve the forests, water quality, and recreation value of the waterways of Washington, DC. Water lilies begin blooming in May and lotus bloom in late-June through July. Peak bloom is July-August. Both open and close daily based on temperature and weather. **Our ranger program takes place over a 1.5-mile route. Be prepared to stand and walk in both sunny and shaded areas and on unpaved trails. Bring water, wear walking shoes, and dress for the weather conditions.**
