Clean paper, cartons & cardboard



METAL PACKAGING

Cans & tins



PLASTIC PACKAGING

ONLY bottles, tubs, jars & jugs



GLASS PACKAGING

Bottles & jars



No other items should be placed in a recycle bin.

When in Doubt, Throw It Out (In the Trash)!

When done right, recycling can help conserve resources. But the blue bin program can only process clean paper, cardboard and certain varieties of metal, plastic and glass packaging. That's it. Placing other non-recyclable items into a blue bin harms the program and reduces the value of local recycling efforts.
