## **Family Partnership Youth Activity Descriptions**

### **Education Services:**

Classroom instruction and tutoring for GED students and classroom instruction for English as a Second Language (ESL) learners. Virtual High School computer based instruction support. Limited options for youth under the age of 18 years old.

### **Employment Services:**

Group and individual activities designed to prepare participants with job and career goals to succeed in career exploration, job search, employment attainment and career advancement. Participants complete applications, resumes, cover letters, informational interviews and mock interviews, etc. Opportunities are also available for job shadowing and paid internships. In addition, related workshops are offered in the areas of Entrepreneurship, Financial Literacy & Key Soft Life Skills.

### **Education Lab:**

Computer- assisted learning options to increase basic skills, improved skills to prepare to take the GED test including the use of GED Academy; complete high school via the Virtual High School; prepare for college and or increase skills for English Language Learners with Rosetta Stone software.

### **Employment Lab:**

Opportunities to complete career assessments; develop and increase skills related to getting and keeping a job; participate in career exploration and job search using workshop and internet resources; and skill building in the use of computer applications such as Word and Excel.

### **Leadership Meetings & Life Skill Development Activities**

Workshops and activities to provide opportunities for character development, peer learning and leadership development designed to give participants a voice in the management and design of FP's programs and services while building advocacy and effective communication skills, critical thinking skills, accountability and responsibility. Other areas of skill building includes daily living, interpersonal skills, decision making, conflict resolution, self-advocacy, and other important aspects of life management while concurrently extending academic learning.

### **Health Education**

Workshops on health related topics important to the well-being of children, youth and families, including workshops on preventive health, reproductive health, child and family health and healthy lifestyles. These workshops are sometimes integrated into leadership and parent education activities.
