Work under this contract includes all labor, equipment and materials necessary to replace the existing 16" diameter stainless steel backpulse header pipe with PVC pipe and all other work necessary for the complete installation in accordance with the drawings and specifications. The backpulse header pipe is located in the lower level of the Membrane/UV Facility at the Ballenger-McKinney Wastewater Treatment Plant. The backpulse header is located approximately 11 feet above finished floor and includes areas with space restrictions due to existing systems that must remain in service during construction.
