

PUBLIC NOTICE

Re: Frederick County Redistricting Commission

The Frederick County Council has extended the deadline for accepting letters of interest and resumes from individuals to volunteer their time to serve on the Frederick County Redistricting Commission until 4:00 p.m. on Friday, March 19, 2021.

The Redistricting Commission is the body vested with the authority to review current council district boundaries to make recommendations to the Council of suggested changes to those district boundaries in order to guarantee equal voter representation through equal, or equivalent, population counts.

The Redistricting Commission shall be composed of up to nine (9) members. Three (3) registered Democratic voters of the County to be selected by the Democratic State Central Committee of Frederick County, three (3) registered Republican voters of the County to be selected by the Republican State Central Committee of Frederick County, and the Council shall appoint two or three additional members of the Commission, as the case may be, who are unaffiliated with any political party for at least two years prior to the date of appointment, to ensure that its total membership equals an odd number. The Council is seeking individuals who will NOT be a candidate for the Office of County Executive or for County Council in 2022.

In accordance to the Frederick County Charter, the Council shall appoint by resolution a Redistricting Commission not later than April 1 of the year following each decennial census date. All meetings will be televised and open to the public.

Names of all interested applicants will be made available to the public. Resumes will be shared only with the members and staff of the Frederick County Council.

***Persons having a desire to serve in this capacity must be
Frederick County residents, a registered voter not affiliated with any political party
for at least two (2) years.***
