**SUBJECT:** 2020 Annual Administrative Review/Bias Based Profiling

Data compiled by the U.S. Census Bureau estimates that Maryland's total population for July 1, 2019 reached 6,045,680 (The total population for Maryland in 2010 was 5,773,552 when the actual Census was taken) – likewise for July 1, 2019, Frederick County's total population was estimated by the Census Bureau at 259,547 (The total population in 2010 for Frederick County was 233,385 when the actual census was taken). The following statistics represent the percentage of population in the State and Frederick County for those racial/ethnic categories tracked by CALEA:

In 2020, the **Frederick County Criminal Investigation Section** applied for a total of **259** search and seizure warrants. The warrants were for residences, vehicles, records, cell phones, computers, social media accounts, DNA, etc. It should also be noted that it is not uncommon for multiple warrants to be written for the same case.

During 2020, the Frederick County Sheriff's Office of Policy and Compliance was notified of no complaints in reference to racial profiling. Reviewing the complaints /investigations for 2020 a vast majority of complaints were minor in nature. One incident

*involved a Departmental Shooting. By policy these are automatically investigated by OPC after the criminal investigation and the States Attorney review is completed. The review is not completed as of the time of this report. There were no citizen complaints in reference to excessive use of force in 2020.*

*During a review of the traffic stop data it should be noted that only stops considered reportable are captured and is per encounter not the total of citations written. The data appears fairly flat with no significant changes. The Sheriff's Office traffic stop data is reported through the electronic system (E-Tix) to the Maryland State Police. This data is then made available to the public through the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention. The data from 2020 should be available in the fall of 2021.*

*In 2020 the Covid Pandemic reduced the number of citizen contacts significantly in traffic stops and should be noted moving forward. No complaints were received related to civil immigration warrants to the Law Enforcement Bureau. Training Services throughout the 2020 calendar year issued several training classes related to race. The classes included Ice NCIC entries, Implicit Bias, Hate Crimes, Anti-Bias Training for Law Enforcement and Racial Profiling.*
