RECENTLY PASSED LEGISLATION

Bill 21-07 passed by 7-0 vote on May 25. This Bill establishes a Disabled Veterans Property Tax Credit and application requirements.

Bill 21-03 passed by 6-1 vote on May 18. This Bill modifies the school construction fee schedule, revising the required payments and annual adjustments.

Bill 21-05 passed by 7-0 vote on May 4. This Bill revises the Frederick County Employees Retirement Plan and creates the Frederick County Uniformed Employees Retirement Plan.
