Limited Agricultural Activity Process and Procedures

The following information is provided in order to assist citizens in making an application for a **Special Exception - Limited Agricultural Activity (LAA)**, in accordance with **Section 1-19-8.325** of the Frederick County zoning ordinance.

Farm Animal (Section 1-19-11.100 Farm Animals)

Those animals ordinarily found on a farm, including but not limited to horses, ponies, sheep, goats, bulls, buffalo, cows, steers, rabbits raised for commercial purposes, turkeys, pigs, ducks, geese, chickens, and guinea hens.

Roosters are not allowed on properties zoned Residential

Limited Agricultural Activity (LAA) shall be permitted in the residential districts where the following provisions are met;

- (A) The keeping of farm animals in conjunction with a single-family residence, on lots less than 3 acres, shall be permitted in residential districts provided that no pens, stalls, or runs will be located closer than 50 feet of any lot line. *Example of a Coop/Run Placement Map – shown on page 2.*
 - (B) All provisions of this chapter shall be met including;
 - a. Section 1-19-8.325 Limited Agricultural Activity in the Residential Zoning Districts
 - b. Section 1-19-8.240 Accessory Uses on Residential Properties, and
 - c. Section 1-19-3.210. Special Exceptions
 - (C) The limited agricultural activity shall not cause any odor, dust, smoke, vibration, or unreasonable noise which can be detected at or beyond the property line

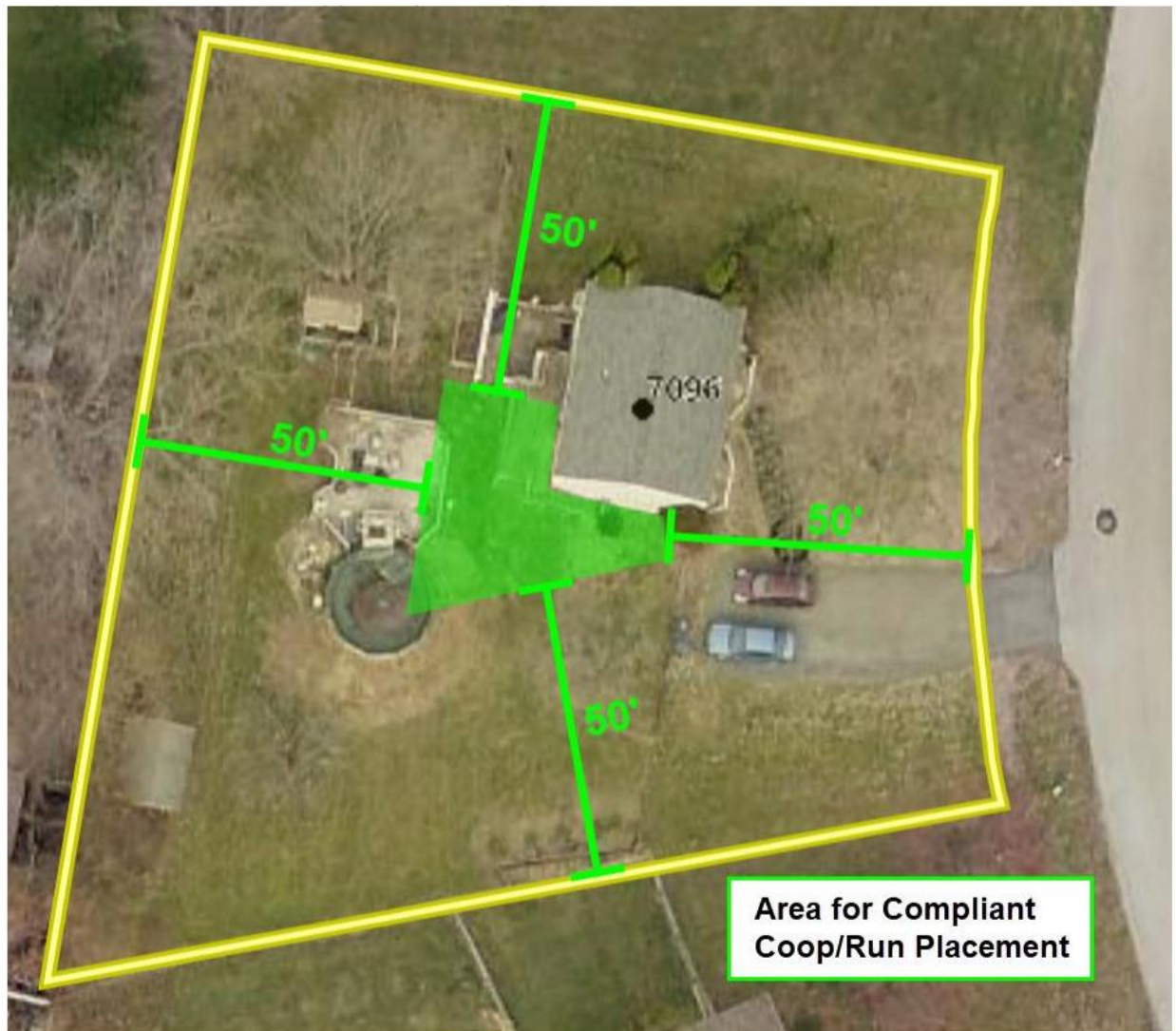
The Application Process in order:

- Contact the Frederick County Division of Planning and Permitting, Zoning Section to confirm that a (LAA) is required in order to have farm animals on the property. **Contact Information Provided Below.**
- If it is determined that approval of a (LAA) is required, you will need to make application to the Board of Appeals (BOA) for a **Special Exception – Limited Agricultural Activity.**
- Link to the Frederick County Permitting Portal is provided below.
- Directions, including pictures, regarding how to submit your application and what needs be provided with your application is also provided below.
- The BOA review process takes about 90 days.

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HOW TO APPLY VIA PUBLIC PORTAL

BOARD OF APPEALS – LIMITED AG ACTIVITY

Required for Submission:

- 1.) Note in the comments the need for Limited Ag Activity and Zoning Planner the applicant spoke with
- 2.) Justification letter, to include the following information:
 - a. Address of property.
 - b. Existing Zoning of Property.
 - c. Proposed use under the zoning ordinance.
 - d. Applicable section(s) of the Zoning Ordinance, for Use Proposed.
 - e. General and or Specific Criteria for limited Ag Activity.
 - f. Other information relevant to special exception request.
- 3.) Concept Plan & Illustrative Notes and other supporting documents. Concept plan must show property boundaries, home & pen location, as well as distances from all property lines to the pen. (Distance from pen to property boundary must be 50 ft or greater)
